Discipline Plan/ Infraction Guidelines

When a student violates a noted offense, the classroom teacher will give the student an infraction and the following guidelines will be followed:

Infraction #1:

- Student/Teacher Conference
- Send Infraction home with Student
- Teacher will determine consequence
- If infraction does not return signed, teacher will call parent

Infraction #2:

- Student/Teacher Conference
- Teacher will call Parent and send Infraction home with student
- Teacher will determine a progressive consequence

Infraction #3:

- Student/Teacher Conference
- Teacher will notify parents and send Infraction home with student
- Teacher will set up a Teacher/Parent/Student Conference
- Conference will lead to classroom behavior contract with Parent and Student

Infraction #4:

- Student/Teacher Conference
- Teacher will call parents to notify them of the 4th Infraction offense and that a letter from the Principal will be sent to their home with a date and a time for a conference with the Principal, Teacher, Parent, and Student. The conference will discuss the issues around the student's continued violation of school rules
- Teacher will complete Office Referral after conversation with Parents
- Letter will be sent home with Student and in the mail
- Principal will determine consequence

Infraction #5:

- Student/Teacher Conference
- Office Referral
- Principal will call Parents
- Referral to COS Team
- Student may be suspended
